O R D E R

Delay condoned.

The petitioners are aggrieved since their long service as the work charged employees has not been taken into consideration for the purpose of service benefits. The High Court, in the impugned Judgment, has gone into the statutory provision regarding the status of work-charged employees and has held that the same cannot be counted for the purpose of seniority or grades etc.

According to the petitioners, there was a recommendation in their favour for counting the said service for the purpose of service benefits. But that relaxation has not seen reflected in

the Government Order. Therefore, we make it clear that the Judgment impugned in this case shall not stand in the way of the petitioners making an appropriate representation before the Government for relaxation in the rules. In case such a representation is filed, the Government may consider the same expeditiously.

We make it clear that the impugned Judgment shall not stand in the way of the Government taking an independent decision.

With the above observations and directions, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.

Pending interlocutory applications, if any, stand disposed of.
