O R D E R

Having heard learned Senior Counsel appearing for the parties and upon perusal of the record, we are not inclined to transfer the complaint bearing File No.113/M titled as "Trans Asian Industries Exposition Pvt. Ltd. & Ors. vs. Mr. Iqbal Malhotra", pending before the Court of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class (Sub-Registrar), Srinagar, to the appropriate criminal Court at Delhi.

Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed.

However, the petitioner's apprehension to the danger of his life should be taken care of by giving him the police protection by the Director General of Police, Jammu & Kashmir.

We order accordingly.

We also direct that if the additional security is required by the petitioner, the State of Jammu & Kashmir shall provide the same by charging the cost from the

petitioner.

The petitioner shall also be at liberty to apply to the High Court of Jammu & Kashmir for hearing of the matter in the Jammu region of the State of Jammu & Kashmir, in view of section 406 of the State Code of Criminal Procedure.
