The parties have settled their disputes and filed a joint application. They have requested this Court to pass an order granting a decree of divorce to Astitva Tyagi and Sonali Tyagi. In addition, the parties requested this Court to close the criminal cases filed by both sides. Pursuant to the compromise, we deem it fit and proper to pass the following order:

The marriage between Astitva Tyagi and Sonali Tyagi shall stand dissolved.

The following criminal cases filed by/ against the Parties are quashed.

1) Complaint No.C-251/2020 under Sections 307, 308, 405, 406, 415, 418, 419, 420, 498A of the IPC registered on 17.06.2020 at CAW Cell, PS Saket, New Delhi.

2) FIR No. 455/2020 under Sections 191, 192, 196, 199, 200, 209, 420, 120-B, and 34 of the IPC in PS Phase II, Noida.

3) Complaint dated 10.07.2020 filed before SHO PS Phase-II Noida Gautam, Budh Nagar.

The transfer petition (C) No.938 of 2020 pending in this court stands closed.

The writ petition and pending application(s),  
if any, stand disposed of, accordingly.
