We have heard petitioner who appeared in person and also learned counsel for the respondent.

Without expressing any opinion on merits, we direct that proceedings in criminal complaint being case No.79/SW of 2012 titled "Mr. Sanjay Kumar Harinarayan Singh Vs. Miss. Sitwat Quazi." on the file of Metropolitan Magistrate, 29<sup>th</sup> Court at Dadar, Mumbai, Maharashtra, shall stand transferred to the District and Sessions Judge, Bhilwara, Rajasthan, for hearing and disposal in accordance with law *who may try the case himself or transfer the same to the court competent to do so*.
