Transfer Petition No.1234/2020 has been filed seeking transfer of H.M.A.No.459 of 2020 titled as Nitin Gupta versus Anjali Gupta which is pending before the Family Court Gurugram, Haryana.

When the matter is taken up for consideration, it is submitted by the learned counsel appearing for both the parties that issues involved in the said case as also the disputes between the parties have been amicably settled.

It is further submitted that though the respondent has moved a petition for a withdrawal of H.M.A.No.459 of 2020, based on the terms of settlement, it has not taken up and disposed of owing to the interim order of stay passed by this Court in respect of proceedings in H.M.A.No.459 of 2020.
