

Taking into consideration the submissions made by the parties that settlement talks are going between them to settle the matrimonial disputes, we feel that the petitioner can continue to be protected from arrest till the charge-sheet is filed in the matter. Ordered accordingly.

We make it clear that if the petitioner fails to resolve the matrimonial dispute for which the respondent – wife has already agreed to, and if the charge-sheet is filed in the matter, the petitioner shall surrender before the concerned Trial Court and obtain a regular bail. If such an application is filed by the petitioner, the Trial Court is directed to dispose of the same expeditiously on its own merits and in accordance with law.

With the above observations, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.
