ORDER

- 1 By an order of this Court dated 28 February 2020, the second petitioner, Prashant Purushottam Sant, was held to be entitled to a deemed date of 30 June 2018 in the capacity of Executive Engineer.
- 2 The grievance which has now been raised in the contempt petition is in regard to the further promotion to the post of Superintendent Engineer. The grievance is that persons junior to the petitioner above named have been called to consent. Since this did not form the subject matter of the earlier proceedings, we are not entertaining the contempt petition. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to pursue such remedies as are available in law, including by way of a writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution.
- 3 Subject to the aforesaid, the contempt petition is disposed of.
- 4 Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
