



We see force in the submission of Mr. Mehta and correct the aforesaid two portions of the order which shall now read as under:-

“Exception is taken to the aforesaid order submitting inter alia that the Status of one of the decree holders namely Respondent No.2 appears to be unclear inasmuch as the information put up on the website of the Ministry of Corporate Affairs shows that said decree holder has a negative net worth of Rs.1.23 crores, while Respondent No.3 has been struck off from ROC records.”

“I) Fifty percent of the money presently lying by way of a Fixed Deposit Receipt in Bank of Baroda which receipt is with the concerned Registry of the Court at Agra, alongwith fifty percent of the sum towards interest in terms of the order of the High Court be transferred to the account of the respondents/decreed holders, subject to:

the respondents/decreed holders giving adequate security to the satisfaction of the learned Registrar of the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad;

II)Only upon furnishing such papers of adequate security, the money representing the fifty percent of the amount in deposit with fifty percent of the interest accrued thereon be transferred to the credit of the respondents/decreed holders.”

The Registry is directed to issue certified copy of the order after effecting necessary corrections in the order as indicated hereinabove.

The Miscellaneous application is disposed of.

Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
