



petitioner shall be recovered from the officials responsible for the delay in disbursal of the DCRG, by proceeding in the manner provided in G.O.(P)No. 185/2002/Fin.dated 27.03.2002."

We see no reason to interfere. However, insofar as the direction to make the payment of interest towards DCRG @ 7% Per annum, we extend the time limit by further two months from today. If the amount is not paid within two months, the direction regarding enhanced rate of interest @ 12% Per annum shall become applicable.

The last sentence of the directions that the amount of interest shall be recovered from the officials responsible for the delay, in our view, was not called for. We, therefore, set aside the last sentence of para 7.

With the aforesaid observations, the SLP is disposed of.

Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
