UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. On 17th July, 2017 notice was issued limited to the purpose of mediation.
2. On 11th May, 2018, the matter was referred to the Bombay High Court Mediation Centre for the parties to explore the possibility of arriving at an amicable settlement. Both the parties state that they have tried their hand at settlement, but did not succeed at that point in time.
3. Today, learned counsel for the parties state in unison that much

water has flown under the bridge and if they are referred back to the Mediation Centre annexed with to Bombay High Court, there is a likelihood of the parties arriving at a settlement.

4. In view of the statement made hereinabove, the parties are referred to the Bombay High Court Mediation Centre for exploring the possibility of a negotiated settlement. The report of the Mediator shall be placed before the Bombay High Court in Family Court Appeal No. 16 of 2011, pending before the said Court.

5. The Petition for Special Leave to Appeal is disposed of in the light of the aforesaid submissions.
