O R D E R

We decline to interfere in this Special Leave Petition as we find that the arrangement referred to in the impugned order was an agreed arrangement.

If the petitioner has failed to comply with the assurance given, nothing more can be done.

However, the petitioner's grievance is that in the

writ petition they had also challenged the order of blacklisting. At least that relief should have been taken forward on merits.

It will be open to the petitioner to approach the High Court by way of review and request the High Court to revive the writ petition limited to the relief of assailing the order of blacklisting. That application can be considered by the High Court on its own merits and in accordance with law.

In the event, the decision in review petition is adverse to the petitioner, it will be open to the petitioner to assail the same by way of fresh special leave petition before this Court.

The Special Leave Petition is disposed of accordingly.
