O R D E R

Contempt Petition (C) Nos. 1131-1132 & 1138-1139/2019 were filed seeking implementation of orders passed in Civil Appeal No. 5797/2019. Said Contempt Petitions were closed on 08.11.2019 after passing appropriate directions. Thereafter aforestated Miscellaneous Applications have been filed by various

applicants submitting inter alia that the directions issued by this Court from time to time were yet to be complied with in full measure.

Ms. Aparna Bhat, learned counsel appearing for the Applicants submits that the concerned directions issued by this Court have now been substantially complied with and payments to the teachers are being released. In view of the statement made by Ms. Bhat, we see no reason to keep these Applications pending any longer.

Ms. Bhat has also invited our attention to M.A. No(s).1605/2020 and submitted that nine similarly situated candidates got left out unfortunately and similar benefit be extended to them. Learned Advocate General drew our attention to the fact that out of those nine persons, four had never been before the Courts at any stage and as such no benefit be conferred upon said four persons. We see force in the submission made by the Advocate General. We therefore, refuse to entertain the request on behalf of said four persons. At the same time, the remaining five persons namely:-

1. Mr. Robindchandra Sarma
2. Mr. Pushpender Sarma
3. Ms. K. Sujata Devi
4. Ms. Nalini Devi
5. Ms. Nivedita Devi

were admittedly before the High Court and this Court and as such we make an exception in their favour and declare that these

five persons may also be given the similar treatment and advantages as have been extended to other candidates, with the exception that they shall be entitled to the posts of teachers and all the benefits with effect from 01.12.2020.

With this clarification, Miscellaneous Applications stand disposed of.
