O R D E R

A family meal together can achieve more than years of litigation in Court! That appears to be what has happened and the brother and sister have been able to resolve their disputes while breaking bread together. Parties have produced before us a Deed of family settlement duly signed by the appellant and respondent No.1 and their counsels. In terms of the settlement, respondent No.1 has accepted the property bearing No.271 situated at Sharda Road, Meerut City in full and final satisfaction of her claim in the suit filed by her. It may however be noticed that in this property one shop has been sold while three shops are on tenancy, an aspect taken care of in the settlement agreement itself.

We are informed that the second sister, respondent No.2, though did partake in the meal but has expressed her intention not to come into these proceedings as she never claimed any rights and in terms of the impugned order also, no share has been allocated to her. The result would be that the settlement would remain binding on the parties who are signatories to the settlement.

We thus take the settlement agreement on record and pass decree in terms thereof, both the appellant and respondent No.1 being bound by the settlement and the disputes about properties mentioned in this compromise stand finally settled.

We appreciate the constructive role played by the learned senior counsels in bringing this dispute to an end as well as the constructive approach adopted by the parties.

The appeals and the Transferred Cases are disposed of in terms of the settlement agreement. Decree be drawn up and settlement agreement shall form part of the decree.
