O R D E R

I.A. NO. 92290/2021- Application for
impleadment is allowed.

The submission of the learned senior counsel
for the petitioner, on instructions, is that as per

the earlier advertisement, the cut off date was stated to be 15.03.2021. The last date for submission of application was 15.04.2021 which was extended to 20.05.2021. She refers to the advertisement which provides that the period of service as an ad hoc teacher is to be counted on the basis of the date of the first disbursement of salary from the State treasury till the last date of submission of on-line application. In this behalf she has drawn our attention to the order passed on 28.06.2021 (Page 94), wherein this Court opined that para 1(9) providing as aforesaid of the advertisement was liable to be set aside and the benefit is to be given for the period of service counted from the date of appointment and non-payment of the amount would not be the basis to shift the point of giving weightage. In pursuance to this order, a corrigendum was issued on 08.07.2021 accordingly.

The grievance now sought to be made is that after the corrigendum, no opportunity was given to submit applications and the portal had been closed on 20.05.2021. On the query of the Court as to why the petitioners could not apply before the last date albeit as per the norms specified prior to corrigendum, learned counsel submits that the portal would not accept such an application and the

petitioners tried to submit their applications.

Thus in view of the aforesaid statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners we consider appropriate to enquire into the issue.
