O R D E RDelay in filing the special leave petitions is
condoned.

Both the petitioner and the respondent are there

before us. This matter arises out of three cheques for a sum of Rs.2.11 lakhs which had been returned on account of insufficient funds. The trial Court sentenced the petitioner to a period of one year together with fine which was confirmed by the Sessions Court; the High Court reduced the period of sentence to six months.

We are now informed by both the petitioner and the respondent, who are appearing before us, that, by deed of compromise dated 21.03.2020 which is taken on record by this Court, Rs. 1 lakh has now been paid in full and final settlement of these proceedings under Section 138 Negotiable Instruments Act. We record the same and, therefore, set aside the sentence of imprisonment and fine.

The special leave petitions are disposed of accordingly.

Pending applications stand disposed of.
