Since the petitioner is convicted for the offence punishable under Section 376(c) IPC, we do not deem it appropriate to entertain this Special Leave Petition.

However, considering the fact that the petitioner has completed more than two years of actual sentence as against the sentence of ten years awarded to him, we request the High Court to dispose of Criminal Appeal No.4964 of 2019 within six months from the receipt of copy of this order.

In case the aforesaid appeal is not disposed of within six months despite the petitioner having extended complete co-operation, the petitioner shall be entitled to prefer appropriate application seeking relief under Section 389 Cr.P.C.

The Special Leave Petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
