O R D E R

By our order dated 08.01.2021, we had acceded to the request of Mrs. Meenakshi Arora, learned Senior Counsel, who was appearing for the petitioner at that point of time to furnish a bank guarantee from the Union Bank of India as earlier bank guarantees

that were produced were, on checking up with the banks involved, found to be fraudulent. Instead of furnishing the requisite Bank Guarantee as per this Court's order, a so-called bank guarantee of the Indian Bank was furnished. On the office finding out from the Indian Bank that this was also fraudulent, an application was moved by the petitioner to replace the aforesaid bank guarantee with a bank guarantee from the Bank of Baroda. On the office further enquiring with the Bank of Baroda as to whether this bank guarantee has, in fact, been furnished by the Bank of Baroda, Mr. M.T. Nimje, Chief Branch Manager, Ulhasnagar Branch, has written to the registry of this Court on March 18, 2021 informing the registry that they have not issued any such bank guarantee.

Given this contumacious conduct of the petitioner, we recall our order dated 19.09.2018 and all subsequent orders thereafter.

Special Leave Petition and Miscellaneous Application stand disposed of.
