UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. Learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner, after arguing for some time states, that the petitioner be permitted to move a recall application before the High Court. Learned counsel also indicates, that when the

petitioner moves such an application before the High Court, the learned counsel would be ready and willing to argue the matter on merits on the very first day.

3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, we grant liberty to the petitioner to move an application for recall of the impugned order dated 23.12.2016.
