The parties were married on 04.12.2011I and out of the wedlock a daughter was born in 2013. The allegations are of dowry and the parties have been staying apart since February, 2016.

The petitioner filed FIR dated 13.8.2016 at Gwalior under Sections 498-A, 34 IPC r/w Sections 3 & 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961.

The respondent husband has filed a divorce petition under Section 13A of Hindu Marriage Act before the Additional District Judge, Family Court, Anoopgarh Taluka, Sriganganagar, Rajasthan.

It is these proceedings for which transfer is sought from the Court of Ld. ADJ, Family Court, Anoopgarh, SrigangaNagar, Rajasthan to the Court of Ld. Principal Judge, Family Court at Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh.

The respondent was served and on two occasions it has been recorded that none has entered appearance for the respondent.

Considering the facts and circumstances on the record, it is considered appropriate to transfer the divorce petition being Family Case No.2 of 2017 titled "Jyotiyendra Singh Sisodiya Vs. The transfer petition stands allowed in the aforesaid terms.
