O R D E R

1. Leave granted.
2. We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties.
3. The appellant has been arraigned as an accused in FIR No.386/2020 for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 326, 307 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.
4. Taking into consideration that the appellant has undergone nearly five years of incarceration, coupled with the fact that the trial has been dragged on at the instance of the co-accused, we are inclined to set aside the impugned order and grant bail to the appellant.

5. Accordingly, the impugned order stands set aside and the appellant is granted bail, subject to the terms and conditions that may be imposed by the Trial Court.
6. The appeal is allowed, accordingly.
