O R D E R

The application is by Class IV employees predicated on their impleadment in the present proceeding. However, as is being rightly pointed out by learned senior counsel appearing for the respondent-LIC, the Scheme is applicable only to Class-III employees and thus our order pertains only to the same. It cannot apply to Class IV employees. It is open to the applicants before us to work out their remedy in the manner they deem appropriate. We may however, note the contention of the learned senior counsel for the LIC that the category IV employees have already been dealt with separately under different proceedings.

The application for direction is accordingly dismissed and MA stands disposed of.
