Leave granted.

On 2.7.2019, following order was passed by this Court:

"Permission to file the special leave petition is granted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was not a party to the proceedings and yet in para 7 of its impugned order, following observations are made by the High Court"

"...Hence, this Court is of the considered opinion that he should not be permitted to occupy in such a covertly service oriented and responsible posts or any other post in future for the welfare of the public at large."

The afore-quoted observations made by the High Court against the appellant are challenged by him. It is an admitted fact that the appellant was not a party to the proceedings and in the circumstances, the High Court ought not to have made any observations touching the character and reputation of the appellant.

The observation so made by the High Court would have far

reaching consequences in so far as career and service of the appellant are concerned.

Considering the entirety of the matter, in our view, those observations were unnecessary for resolving the lis which came up for consideration and are required to be deleted.

Ordered accordingly.

The appeal is allowed to the aforesaid extent.
