

of deposit of Rs.30 lakhs as mentioned above. He could muster only Rs. 10 lakhs which he deposited before the trial Court. As the petitioner did not comply with the condition imposed by order dated 08.06.2020, the interim bail that was granted to the petitioner was cancelled and the petitioner was directed to surrender forthwith.

Aggrieved thereby, the petitioner is before us seeking extension of time for deposit of the amount as directed by the High Court. The petitioner submits that he is alleged to have cheated the complainant for an amount of 1.47 crore by the petitioner. He has already paid Rs. 1.27 crores. The balance amount of Rs.20 lakhs could not be paid in view of the Pandemic.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, we extend the time for payment of Rs.20 lakhs by a period of four weeks from today. In case, the petitioner does not deposit the amount within a period of four weeks the order passed by the High Court shall revive.

The petitioner shall not be arrested in the meanwhile.

The Special leave petition is disposed of accordingly. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
