O R D E R

1. We have heard Mr. Keshav Kumar, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned counsel appearing for the respondents.

2. This petition arises from an interlocutory order passed by the High Court of Judicature at Rajasthan Bench at Jaipur dated 08.11.2019 in S.B.Civil Writ Petition No. 11028 of 2019 filed by the respondent no.1 herein.

3. The impugned order came to be passed by the High Court on the stay application.

4. It appears that the High Court after hearing all the parties stayed the operation of the orders dated 06.01.2014 and 30.04.2019 respectively. This litigation has something to do with LPG distributorship. Since the main matter is before the High Court, we see no good reason to interfere with this interlocutory order granting relief to the petitioner before the High Court who is respondent no.1 before us.

5. The High Court shall decide the main matter on its own merits without being influenced by the fact that this Court declined to interfere with the impugned order.

6. In the aforesaid, the petition is disposed of accordingly.
