O R D E R

This transfer petition has been filed by the petitioner-wife seeking transfer of Divorce Petition No. 98 of 2018 titled as Sri Nishant Verma vs. Smt. Shivi pending before the court of the Principal Judge, Family Court, Ajmer, Rajasthan to the court of the District Judge at Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh.

The Matrimonial suit under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 was apparently filed on 07.06.2018. The transfer petition was filed on 28.08.2020. The matrimonial suit is at the evidence stage.

In view of the delay in filing the transfer petition, this Court does not deem it appropriate to entertain the same. The transfer petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

However, the respondent-husband shall pay the expenses of travel of the petitioner to Ajmer from Lucknow and back with an escort and also the expenses of accommodation in Ajmer reasonable to her status as wife of the respondent-husband.
