Leave granted.

This appeal has been filed against the order dated 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2020 passed by the High Court in Criminal Appeal No. 2980/2020, by which the bail application filed by the appellant has been dismissed.

The appellant is an accused in a case under Sections 376 (2) (n) and 506 of the IPC and Sections 3(1)(d)(dha), 3(1)(w)(ii) and 3(2)(v) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

We have heard learned counsel for the appellant, learned counsel for the State and learned counsel for the complainant.

Learned counsel for the appellant referred to the complaint filed by the complainant on 13<sup>th</sup> August, 2019 which is annexed as Annexure P/2.

Learned counsel for the State submits that initially the appellant has not acknowledged the complainant and his wife in the anticipatory bail application.

According to the appellant, the allegation is that the

appellant got married to the complainant in 2016 and without informing her got married to another girl later.

Be that as it may, in the facts of the present case, the case has been made out for release of the appellant on bail and we order accordingly. The appellant be released on bail on such terms and conditions as may be fixed by the Trial Court. One of the condition, which may be included in the conditions, is that the appellant in any manner shall not influence / intimidate the witnesses.

The criminal appeal stands disposed of.
