O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. Leave granted.
3. These appeals have been filed against the order dated 16.05.2023 in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 66202 of 2022 and Order dated 10.01.2025 in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 80699 of 2024 in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 66202 of 2022 passed by the High Court of Judicature at Patna.
4. Brief facts of the case are that the High Court granted the anticipatory bail to the appellant in connection with Complaint Case no. 1093 of 2021 for the offences punishable under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 but with the condition to deposit Rs. 18,26,000/- in the Nazarat of the Trial Court. However, it is evident from the impugned order dated 16.05.2023 that the appellant

himself has offered to deposit the aforesaid amount. Thereafter, being unable to pay the said amount, the appellant moved a modification application before the High Court for waiving of the condition to deposit Rs. 18,26,000/- which got dismissed by the High Court vide the impugned order dated 10.01.2025.

5. Inasmuch as the appellant is unable to comply with the condition of depositing the aforesaid amount, the order granting anticipatory bail is liable to be modified. Accordingly, the impugned order stands modified to the effect that the condition to deposit the aforesaid amount is set aside.

6. The appeals stand allowed, accordingly.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
