Heard Shri S.K. Rungta, learned senior counsel, appearing for  
the petitioner and Shri S.V. Raju, learned ASG, appearing for the  
State.

This special leave petition has been filed against the order  
of the High Court dated 26.08.2020 by which the prayer of the  
petitioner for grant of interim bail in pursuance to FIR  
No.100/2020 has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has prayed for only grant of interim bail for 45 days which benefit was already extended to the co-accused by order dated 17.04.2020 by the learned Magistrate.

Learned ASG appearing for the State submits that the petitioner's prayer can be considered in view of the fact that petitioner is a lady and co-accused has already been extended the benefit and the maximum sentence is seven years.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, we are of the opinion that petitioner be released on interim bail for a period of 45 days on terms and conditions as fixed by the Trial Court. We order accordingly.

The special leave petition is disposed of.
