O R D E R

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties, the averments made in the transfer petition, and in the interest of justice, the transfer petition is allowed.

Accordingly, the Family Suit No. 1214 of 2019 title "Patel Saurabh Jashubhai vs. Mala Saurabh Patel" pending before the Principal Family Judge, Vadodara, Gujarat is directed to be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu.

Records of the case would be immediately transferred to the Court of competition jurisdiction at Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu.

To cut short delay, parties are directed to appear in-person or through the authorized representatives or through video-conferencing, if the said facility is available before the Court of competent jurisdiction Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu on 14.10.2022. In case there is non-appearance on behalf of the party on the date fixed, court notice would be issued by the transferee court to the defaulting party.

The parties may explore the possibility of settlement through mediation. The transferee court would obtain the desire and wishes of the parties and proceed accordingly in this regard.

The transferee court would decide the matter expeditiously.
