O R D E R

The accused were convicted under Section 307 read with Section 120-B IPC and also under Sections 25(1)(a) and 27(1) of the Arms Act and were sentenced to suffer imprisonment for five years on each of the aforesaid counts. The sentences were directed to run concurrently.

In an appeal arising therefrom, the application preferred under Section 389 Cr.P.C. was allowed by the High Court which order is presently under challenge.

It is stated that the accused have undergone imprisonment ranging from 7 months to 14 months.

In the circumstances, we see no reason to interfere in the matter.

We, however, request the High Court to take up the criminal appeal itself for hearing as early as possible and preferably within six months from today.

The special leave petition are, accordingly, dismissed.
