1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner-wife seeking transfer of Case bearing F.C.O.P. No. 202 of 2019 titled Sri Pushpank s/o Ashwini Kumar vs. Aashi w/o Sri Pushpank from the Court of IIIrd Additional Family Judge of Ranga Reddy District, Malkajgiri at Telangana State to the Family Court at Ahmedabad, Gujarat.

2. Notice was issued to the sole respondent. Despite service of notice, no one has entered appearance on his behalf.

3. we have heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner-wife and perused the averments made in the instant petition.

4. In the facts and circumstances of the case, Case bearing F.C.O.P.
