

work out a system. In fact the State has stated after consultation with the Registrar of the High Court that in many cases when the appeals come up for hearing, the counsel for the accused don't want to argue the appeals but are only interested in bail.

It is not possible to have all the matters brought before this Court and thus we think that the appropriate course of action for these petitioners is to approach the High Court so that either the High Court will take up the appeals for hearing or may consider enlargement on bail depending upon the factual scenario of each case. It is not possible for this Court to take up all individual cases pending before the High Court whether before the Lucknow Bench or the Allahabad High Court.

We thus, dismiss these petitions with liberty to the petitioners to approach the High Court.

Pending applications stand disposed of.
