The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

Learned counsel appearing for the applicant has filed two Interlocutory Applications i.e., (i) seeking exemption from filing attested affidavits and the (ii) for seeking directions for grant of further eight weeks' time to him to surrender before the Trial Court for undergoing the remaining part of the sentence.

Application seeking exemption from filing attested affidavits is allowed.

By an order dated 22-7-2020 of this Court, the appeal filed by the appellant was dismissed and he was granted two months' time to surrender before the concerned Trial Court to complete the remaining period of sentence imposed upon him, failing which the concerned Police Authorities were directed to take him into custody for the said purpose.

Having heard the learned counsel appearing for the applicant and taking into consideration the fact that he is out of country, we grant further two weeks' time from today to him to surrender before the trial Court for completing the remaining period of sentence.

With the above observation, the Interlocutory Application is allowed.
