We have heard the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner.

There are concurrent findings of fact given by all the courts below holding the petitioner guilty under Section 304A of the IPC for the rash and negligent driving and due to which two persons died and two grievously injured. The findings of fact are on appreciation of evidence on record.

No interference of this Court is called for. It is to be noted that though not required, the High Court has already shown unnecessary leniency and has reduced the punishment from one year simple imprisonment to six months simple imprisonment.

The Special Leave Petition stands dismissed.
