O R D E R

The present Writ Petition has been filed under Article 32 of the Constitution with the following prayers:

"A. Quash all the FIRs (mentioned at Page Nos. M to O and Q to T) filed second after the First FIR No. 34/2016, Sarkarwada Police Station;

B. In the alternative, club and transfer all the FIRs and investigations thereof mentioned in the present writ petition (mentioned at Page Nos. M to O and Q to T) or any other FIR filed in connection with the alleged fraud of the Company with the First FIR No. 34/2016 in Sarkarwada Police Station.

C. Enlarge the petitioner on bail in the aforesaid crime numbers registered against the petitioner; and

D. Pass such other orders, as may be deemed fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.”
