

the while he had worked on cases concerning issues under PMLA Act, 2002 and he has been now moved to the domain concerning FEMA Regulations and Violations. The petitioner submits that the transfer in question is vindictive.

The issues raised by the petitioner will require factual assessment and analysis. While exercising our jurisdiction under Article 32 of the Constitution of India, it will not be possible to go into such factual aspects and the question whether the transfer was vindictive or not.

We, therefore, refuse to entertain this petition. Hence, this Writ Petition is dismissed leaving all questions open to be agitated in properly instituted proceedings.

Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
