O R D E R

The respondent has been served but none has chosen to appear on behalf of the respondent-State.

Leave granted.

We have heard learned counsel for the appellant.

We find from the record that charge sheet has been filed. The appellant was married to the deceased on 7th December, 2014 and that she was found hanging on 24.04.2020. It is the case of the appellant that she was suffering from depression and was being treated by a Neuropsychiatrist at a Hospital. However, the family of the deceased filed the complaint and the bail application post custody was dismissed.

The appellant also states that he has a three years old son and unnecessary doubts have been cast on him.

On hearing learned counsel for the appellant and perusing the record as also the post mortem report which says that the cause of

death was asphyxia due to hanging and no internal or external injuries were found, the charge sheet having been filed, we enlarge the appellant on bail on terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.

The appeal stands disposed of.
