UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

- 1 The High Court of Punjab & Haryana, declined to grant anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Criminal Procedure Code 1973. In view of the bar

contained in the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes(Prevention of Atrocities) Act 1989 against the grant of pre-arrest bail, the view of the High Court cannot be held to be erroneous.

- 2 Having due regard to the fact that the petitioners were granted an ad-interim protection against arrest by the order of this Court dated 11 September 2020, we extend the protection by a further period of three weeks from today. It would be open to the petitioners to surrender before the competent court and apply for regular bail and if such an application is made, it shall be considered expeditiously.
- 3 The Special Leave Petition is accordingly disposed of.
- 4 Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
