We have heard Mr. V. Ramasubramanian, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

We are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order in exercise of our jurisdiction under Article 136 of the Constitution of India.

The special leave petition is disposed of giving liberty to the petitioner to appear and move an application for recall of Non-bailable Warrant (NBW) before the concerned Trial Court within three weeks. Such prayer as and when made shall be considered and decided by the Trial Court expeditiously. For a period of three weeks or till the application of recall of NBW is decided by the Trial Court whichever is earlier, the petitioner shall remain protected against arrest.
