O R D E R**

- 1 Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners states that prayer (iii) as sought in the proceedings under Article 136 of the Constitution has been rendered infructuous by certain developments which have taken place in the meantime in regard to the treatment protocols for Covid-19 patients.

- 2 Insofar as the prayer (ii) is concerned, learned counsel states that the petitioners would not press the proceedings before this Court having regard to the question of medical expertise involved, but would pursue their suggestions before the authorities concerned.
- 3 On the request of the learned counsel, in the above circumstances, the Petition is permitted to be withdrawn. However, the costs imposed by the High Court shall stand deleted.
- 4 The Special Leave Petition is permitted to be withdrawn.
