Delay in preferring the review petition is condoned.

After considering the entirety of the matter and the rival submissions it was found by this Court that the finding rendered by the trial court that the plaintiff was not ready and willing to perform his obligations under the contract, was not expressly set aside by the High Court. In the circumstances while accepting the view taken by the lower appellate court in rejecting the relief of specific performance, this Court directed that as against the sum of Rs.4 lakhs received by way of earnest by original defendant Nos.1 to 5, the subsequent

transferee shall make over a sum of Rs.20 lakhs to the original plaintiff.

We have gone through the Review Petition and do not find any substance in the petition, nor do we find any error apparent on record to justify interference.

This Review Petition is dismissed.
