We have heard learned senior counsel for the petitioners.

We are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order(s).

The Special Leave Petitions are dismissed.

It is stated that the charge-sheet has been filed. The petitioners may apply for regular bail and on such application(s) being filed, the trial Court will consider the same as expeditiously as possible.
