The main question involved in these appeals is about the payment of solatium. The question of payment of solatium has been settled by a three Judge Bench of this Court in Nagpur Improvement Trust vs. Vasantrao & Ors. [(2002) 7 SCC 657] where Punjab Town Improvement Act, 1922 has been

considered and it has been held that solatium is payable. In the quantum of compensation which has been determined by the High Court, we find no justification at all to interfere. The compensation determined by the High Court is found to be appropriate, hence no case for interference in the appeals is made out. Consequently, the appeals are dismissed. No costs.
