ORDER

This petition has been filed by the petitioner/wife under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 seeking transfer of H.M.O.P. No. 1703/2018 pending before the Family Court, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu to the Family Court, Saket Court, New Delhi.

Today, the respondent remained unrepresented. He has not filed counter affidavit in spite of opportunity given to him. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is residing at Delhi with her parents and it would be difficult for her to contest the case at Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu.
