We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

We are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order.

26th July, 2004 i.e. for a period over 16 years. It is not clear whether the case of the petitioner has been examined for release.

We direct the State of Uttar Pradesh to place the case of the petitioner before the concerned Board for release and a decision be taken on the same within a maximum period of two months from today.
