O R D E R

Heard Mr. Pawanshree Agrawal, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. Ujjwal Pandey and Ms. Vivya Nagpal, learned counsel for the contesting respondents and Mr. Atul Sharma, learned counsel for the State.

We Have been apprised that out of six eye witnesses cited to be examined in support of the case of the prosecution, four have already been examined. Additionally, the Doctor's testimony as well as that of the investigating officer's is also over.

It is accepted that the main accused named Sanju Vishwas who is alleged to have used the fire arm, is still in custody. Out of five accused involved in the matter, three have been bailed out while Sanju Vishwas and Avinash Vishwas are still in custody.

In the circumstances, we see no reason to interfere with the orders granting bail to Subhash Vishwas and Ranjeet Sarkar. We, however, direct the trial court to conclude the trial as early as possible and preferably within six months from the receipt of the copy of this order.

The special leave Petitions stand disposed of accordingly.

Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
