O R D E R

The present Special Leave Petition arises out of the impugned order dated 24.08.2020 passed by the High Court of Jharkhand at Ranchi refusing to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner in connection with the FIR in question for the offences under Sections 420, 323, 341 and 504 of the IPC.

By order dated 18.09.2020, while issuing notice, the petitioner has been protected from arrest.

Today, when the present Petition is taken up for further hearing, Shri Shoeb Alam, learned counsel, appearing on behalf of the petitioner has stated at the Bar that, during the pendency of the proceedings, the parties have settled the disputes amicably and an appropriate application along with the Consent Terms is submitted before the concerned Court.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing anything on the Settlement entered into between the petitioner and the original Complainant, subject to cooperation by the petitioner in the investigation, the order dated 18.09.2020 is made absolute and it is directed that in case of arrest of the petitioner in connection with the FIR in question, he may be released on bail on the terms and conditions that may be determined by the learned trial Court.

The present Special Leave Petition stands disposed of.
