d) O.S. No.1181/2020 pending on the file of CCH-16, Bengaluru next date of hearing 27.02.2026 (Chandrashekhar Naidu v. Dhanalakshmi and others)."

The above-mentioned cases shall stand quashed/terminated in view of the aforesaid Settlement Agreement. The parties shall abide by the terms of the said Settlement Agreement and the settlement Agreement shall form part of this order.

The appeal stands disposed of, accordingly.
