**UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R**

- 1 The judgment of this Court dated 23 July 2020 (Annexure A-3) directed, while dismissing the appeal, that payment of Rs 2 lakhs in compliance with the order of the NCDRC should be made within two months. The relevant part of the direction reads as follows:

“14 Subject to the aforesaid clarification, in the peculiar facts, which we have noted above, we are not inclined to entertain the appeal only on the ground of the smallness of the quantum involved. The appeal is accordingly dismissed but with the above clarifications. The payment of Rs 2 lakhs in compliance of the order of the NCDRC shall be made to the original complainant within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Time to pay the amount of Rs 2 lakhs is accordingly extended.”

The above direction extended the time which was fixed by the order of the NCDRC by a further period of two weeks. The clear implication of this direction is that **no interest would be payable** and the entire claim would be satisfied on the payment of Rs 2 lakhs.

- 2 We clarify accordingly and extend time for payment of the amount of Rs 2 lakhs by a period of three weeks from today.
