O R D E R

Leave granted.

By order dated 25.09.2020 this Court while issuing notice had extended the interim bail granted by the High Court.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, we are inclined to dispose of the present appeal by directing the trial Court to complete the trial within a period of four months from the date copy of this order is received by the trial Court. Further, the trial Court will be entitled to cancel the bail in case the appellant does not co-operate or the prosecution is able to show that the appellant has involved in any other criminal case post the registration of the FIR in the present case.

Subject to the aforesaid, the bail granted would continue till the disposal of the criminal case arising out of FIR No. III/210/2018 registered with Ankleshwar (Rural) Police Station. To ensure compliance, the trial Court may direct the appellant to furnish bail bond on terms and conditions it deems appropriate.

Impugned order is set aside and appeal is allowed on the aforesaid terms.
